Arrested by the Gestapo and deported, he remained until the end of his life a tireless campaigner memory of the Resistance.

As a Railwayman, he joined the Federation CGT confederation and became its secretary general in 40 years.

Georges Seguy has left its imprint the social scene, particularly during the 1968 strikes that led to the Grenelle agreements of which he was a key architect.
